### **A short lesson on the qualities of the risen body:**

The bodies of the just will be refashioned and transfigured to the pattern of the risen Christ. St. Paul writes of the qualities of the risen bodies of the just: "*It (the body) is sown in corruption; it shall rise in incorruption. It is sown in dishonor; it shall rise in glory. It is sown in weakness; it shall rise in power. It is sown a natural body; it shall rise a spiritual body.*" (1 Cor. 42-44). The Church teaches these four qualities of the risen body under the following titles:

- 1. Impassibility:** incapable of suffering any evil, e.g. sorrow, sickness, death. "*And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; death shall be no more; nor mourning, nor crying, nor sorrow shall be any more; for the former things are passed away.*" (Lk 20:36).
- 2. Clarity:** free from all deformity and endowed with the beauty of radiance. "*The just shall shine as the sun in the kingdom of the Father.*" (Mt 13:43).
- 3. Agility:** capability of the body to obey the soul with the greatest ease and speed of movement. "*And it came to pass, whilst he was at table with them... their eyes were opened and he vanished out of their sight.*" (Lk 24:31).
- 4. Subtily:** a spiritualizing of the body, but not the transformation into a spiritual essence (like an angel). The body shall be able to pass through material objects, "*Now when it was late that same day... and the doors were shut, where the apostles gathered... Jesus came and stood in their midst...*" (Jn 20:19) or have contact with them, "*See my hands and my feet; that it is I myself; handle and see; for a spirit has not flesh and bones, as you see me to have*" (Lk 24:39)... at reason's command.

*...the hireling flees, because he is a hireling...*

Sons patiently wait for the eternal inheritance of the Father. The hireling is impatient for the temporal wage of the hirer. Gather the grape cluster; beware of the thorns. For the clusters, growing up from the root of the vine, sometimes hang amidst the thorns. For many within the Church preach Christ while pursuing earthly gain; and yet through them the voice of Christ is heard, and the sheep follow: not indeed the voice of the hireling, but the voice of the Shepherd spoken through the hireling.
