ON THE GOSPEL

When the Paraclete comes, whom I will send you from the Father, the Spirit of Truth, who proceeds from the Father, he shall give testimony of me.

The Holy Ghost does not proceed from the Father to the Son, and from the Son proceed to the sanctifying of the creature, but proceeds at the same time from Both.
