**Next week,** there will be the Corpus Christi Procession to three altars outside the main church. Also, good or bad weather, there is the annual St. Michael's picnic at Canyon Park shelter number 3 (the first shelter off Jackson Blvd going west).

**Short course on the Divine Majesty** (from Fundamentals of Catholic Dogma):

1 Nature – **One Divine substance** having all perfections of existence.

2 Processions – **two internal Divine Processions**; the Begetting of the Son and the Procession of the Holy Spirit from the Father and the Son.

3 Persons – in virtue of the Processions, there are in God **three Hypostases or Persons** really distinct from one another. The Father who begets, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds.

4 Relations – in virtue of the Processions, there exist in God **four real relationships**: the Father to the Son (active generation, paternity); the Son to the Father (passive generation, filiation); the Father and the Son to the Holy Ghost (active spiration); the Holy Spirit to the Father and the Son (passive spiration).

5 Notions – there are **five internal Divine activities** which characterize the Persons and distinguish them: Innascibility and Active Generation of the Father; Passive Generation of the Son; the Passive Spiration of the Holy Spirit; the Active Spiration of the Holy Spirit (not strictly a notion as this activity is common both of the Father and of the Son.)

## ON THE GOSPEL

*...in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.*

What Catholic is unaware that the Father is truly Father; the Son, truly Son; the Holy Spirit, truly Holy Spirit?
