### ON THE GOSPEL

*...and upon this rock I will build My Church,...*

In fine, to prove to you that it is really Peter of whom it is said: *And on this rock*, - I bring forward the words that follow. For it is all one to promise him *the keys of the kingdom of heaven*, and to say to him: *Upon this rock*; now we cannot doubt that it is St. Peter to whom He promises the keys of the kingdom of heaven, since He says clearly: *And to thee I will give the keys of the kingdom of heaven*: if therefore we do not wish to disconnect this piece of the Gospel from the preceding and the following words in order to place it elsewhere at our fancy, we cannot believe but that all this is said to St. Peter and of St. Peter: *Thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church*. And this the Catholic Church, when, even according to the admission of the ministers, she was true and pure, has confessed loudly and clearly in the assembly of 630 Bishops at the Council of Chalcedon (451 AD).
